IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Ticonic Foot Bridge
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 4 of chapter 37 of the Private and Special Laws
2 of 1899 is hereby amended by inserting the word 'not'
3 between the words "shall" and "apply" in the fourth line
4 thereof so that said section as amended shall read as
5 follows:

'Sect. 4. A toll is hereby granted and established for
7 the benefit of said corporation, not exceeding two cents
8 for each foot passenger crossing said bridge, and the pro-
9 visions of section one of chapter fifty of the Revised
10 Statutes shall not apply to said corporation.'
