## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Ticonic Foot Bridge Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 4 of chapter 37 of the Private and Special Laws

- 2 of 1899 is hereby amended by inserting the word 'not'
- 3 between the words "shall" and "apply" in the fourth line
- 4 thereof so that said section as amended shall read as
- 5 follows:
  - 'Sect. 4. A toll is hereby granted and established for
- 7 the benefit of said corporation, not exceeding two cents
- 8 for each foot passenger crossing said bridge, and the pro-
- 9 visions of section one of chapter fifty of the Revised
- 10 Statutes shall not apply to said corporation.'
