### STATE OF MAINE.

!N THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend section five of chapter one hundred of the Public laws of 1891 relative to camp fires.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section five of chapter one hundred of the 2 Public Laws of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one

3 is hereby amended by striking out the following words:

4 "Any person who shall build a camp or cooking fire in

5 or adjoining any woods in this state, shall, before leaving 6 such camp, totally extinguish such fire," and inserting in

7 place thereof the following words: 'Whoever by him-

8 self, or by his servant, agent or guide, or as the servant,

9 agent or guide of any other person shall build a camp, 10 cooking or other fire, or use an abandoned camp, cooking 11 or other fire, in or adjacent to any woods in this state, 12 shall, before leaving such fire, totally extinguish the 13 same; also by striking out the words "not exceeding one 14 hundred," and inserting in place thereof the words, of 15 fifty, and also by adding thereto the words, one-half of 16 any fine imposed and collected under this section shall be 17 paid to the complainant, so that said section as amended, 18 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 5. Whoever by himself, or by his servant, agent or 20 guide, or as the servant, agent, or guide of any other person, 21 shall build a camp, cooking, or other fire, or use an aban-22 doned camp, cooking or other fire in or adjacent to any 23 woods in this state, shall, before leaving such fire, totally 24 extinguish the same, and upon failure to do so such per-25 son shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon 26 conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of fifty dol-27 lars, provided that such fires built upon the sea beach in 28 such situation that they cannot spread into forest wood or 29 cultivated lands or meadows, shall not be constructed as 30 prohibited by this aet. One-half of any fine imposed and 31 collected under this section shall be paid to the com-32 plainant.'
