## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter sixty-nine of the Private Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, relating to the Waldo and Penobscot Agricultural Society.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section two of chapter sixty-nine of the Private and

- 2 Special Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, is hereby
- 3 amended by adding after the word, "Newburg" in the
- 4 fourth line the words 'and Hampden,' so that the section
- 5 will read as follows:

'Said society is established within and for the towns of

- 7 Monroe, Frankfort, Winterport, Prospect, Swansville,
- 8 Brooks and Jackson, in the county of Waldo, and the towns

9 Dixmont, Newburg and Hampden, in the county of Penob-10 scot, and may take and hold property, real and personal, 11 not exceeding ten thousand dollars, to be applied to the 12 advancement of agriculture and the mechanic arts.'
