STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter sixty-nine of the Private Laws of
eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, relating to the Waldo and
Penobscot Agricultural Society.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section two of chapter sixty-nine of the Private and
2 Special Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, is hereby
3 amended by adding after the word, "Newburg" in the
4 fourth line the words 'and Hampden,' so that the section
5 will read as follows :

'Said society is established within and for the towns of
7 Monroe, Frankfort, Winterport, Prospect, Swansville,
8 Brooks and Jackson, in the county of Waldo, and the towns

9 Dixmont, Newburg and Hampden, in the county of Penob-
10 scot, and may take and hold property, real and personal,
11 not exceeding ten thousand dollars, to be applied to the
12 advancement of agriculture and the mechanic arts.'
