STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter thirty-four of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, relating to the protection and propogation of eels in Damariscotta river and pond.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section one of chapter thirty-four of the Private and
2 Special Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight is
3 hereby amended by striking out the words, “and Novem-
4 ber” in the third and fourth lines of said section, also by
5 inserting the word ‘and’ after the word “September” in the
6 third line of said section, so that said section, as amended,
7 shall read as follows :

‘Sect. 1. It shall not be lawful for any person to catch
9 or take eels from Damariscotta river or pond during the
10 months of May, June, July, August, September and
11 October, by potting, trapping, netting, or by any other
12 device ; and any person so offending shall, on conviction,
13 forfeit and pay a fine of not less than five, nor more than
14 twenty dollars, to be recovered in an action of debt, one-
15 half to the complainant, and the other half to the town
16 where the offense is committed, before any trial justice in
17 the county of Lincoln.’
