STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter eighty-four of the
Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-
five, relating to the taking of smelts in the bays, harbors
and coves in the town of Surry.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section two of chapter eighty-four of the Private and
2 Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five is
3 hereby amended by striking out all of said section after
4 the word "than" in the fourth line thereof, and substitut-
5 ing in place thereof the words, 'one hundred dollars nor
6 more than five hundred dollars, one-half to go to the com-

7 plainant, or by imprisonment not less than sixty days,
8 and imprisoned in said jail for the same time for non-
9 payment of said fine,' so that said section, as amended,
10 shall read as follows :

‘Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate the provisions of this
12 act shall on conviction of the same before any municipal
13 court or trial justice of said county of Hancock, be pun-
14 ished by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars nor
15 more than five hundred dollars, one-half to go to the com-
16 plainant, or by imprisonment not less than sixty days,
17 and imprisoned in said jail for the same time for non-
18 payment of said fine.’
