STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend Section forty-eight of Chapter two hundred and eighty-five of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, relating to sea and shore fisheries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section forty-eight of chapter two hundred 2 and eighty-five of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred 3 and ninety-seven is hereby amended by striking out of 4 the fourth and fifth lines of said section the words, "into 5 the treasury of the county in which the offense is comfemitted, and by such treasurer," so that said section as 7 amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 48. All fines and penalties under this act may be 9 recovered by complaint, indictment or action of debt made 10 or brought by any person in the county where the offense 11 is committed, and shall be paid to the state treasurer, to 12 be added and made a part of the appropriation for sea and 13 shore fisheries.'
