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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

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AN ACT to authorize the Linn Woolen Company to make,  
generate, sell, distribute and supply gas and electricity.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Linn Woolen Company, a corporation  
2 duly authorized and existing under the laws of the State  
3 of Maine is hereby authorized and empowered to make,  
4 generate, sell, distribute and supply gas and electricity, or  
5 both for lighting, heating, manufacturing or mechanical  
6 purposes in the towns of Hartland, St. Albans and Palmyra,  
7 or for either or any of said purposes, notwithstanding the  
8 existing rights of any other person, company or corporation.

Sect. 2. In the exercise of said power, said company  
2 shall be subject to all the duties, restrictions and liabilities,  
3 and have all the power, privileges, rights and immunities  
4 provided by law in respect to companies incorporated for  
5 such purposes.
