STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to authorize George H. Hunt to erect and maintain
a wharf into the tide waters of the St. Croix river in the
town of Robbinston, county of Washington.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Geo. H. Hunt, and his assigns, is hereby
2 authorized to erect and maintain a wharf at Hunt's Point, in
3 the town of Robbinston, in the county of Washington, to be
4 extended thirty or thirty-five feet below low water mark.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
