IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to Amend Section 17 of Chapter 17 of the Revised Statutes Relating to Stationary Engines.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section seventeen of chapter seventeen of the

- 2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting in the first
- 3 line of said section, after the word "stationary," the words
- 4 'gasoline or,' so that when said section is amended it shall
- 5 read as follows:

'Section 17. No stationary, gasoline or steam engine shall

- 7 be erected in a town until the municipal officers have
- 8 granted license therefor, designating the place where the
- 9 buildings therefor shall be erected, the materials and mode

10 of construction, the size of the boiler and furnace, and such 11 provision as to height of chimney or flues, and protection 12 against fire and explosion as they judge proper for the safety 13 of the neighborhood. Such license shall be granted on 14 written application, recorded in the town records, and a 15 certified copy of it furnished, without charge, to the 16 applicant.
