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## STATE OF MAINE,

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

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AN ACT additional to chapter eighty-six of the Revised Statutes  
regulating the Costs of Parties summoned as Trustee.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Chapter eighty-six of the Revised Statutes is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following section:

'Sect. 91. A party summoned as trustee and required to  
4 attend court and make a disclosure, shall be entitled to costs  
5 as follows:

If the claim sued for does not exceed twenty dollars such  
7 trustee shall be entitled to travel and attendance and twenty-  
8 five cents for the oath; and if the claim sued for exceeds

9 twenty dollars, such trustee shall be entitled to two dollars  
10 and fifty cents in addition to the above fee, and when required  
11 to attend court for further examination such trustee shall be  
12 entitled to travel and attendance, at the term only at which  
13 such further examination is had.'
