STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to fix the salary of the Register of Deeds for the
County of Androscoggin.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The register of deeds for Androscoggin county
2 shall receive an annual salary of sixteen hundred dollars,
3 payable quarterly, said salary to be paid from the county
4 treasury and to be instead of the fees now provided by law ;
5 which fees shall be paid into the county treasury for the use
6 of said county.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect April one, in the year
2 of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and one.
