STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to prevent the throwing of sawdust and other refuse matter into the tributaries of the lakes and ponds in Vienna and Mt. Vernon.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to put, or
2 allow the same to be done by any person within his employ,
3 any sawdust, slabs, edgings, or other refuse matter into any
4 of the tributaries to any of the ponds or lakes lying wholly
5 or partly in the towns of Vienna and Mt. Vernon, Kennebec
6 county, under a penalty of not less than fifty dollars nor more
7 than one hundred dollars for each offense, one-half of the
8 fine shall be paid to the complainant, the other half to the
9 treasurer of the state for the benefit of the inland fish and
10 game fund.
