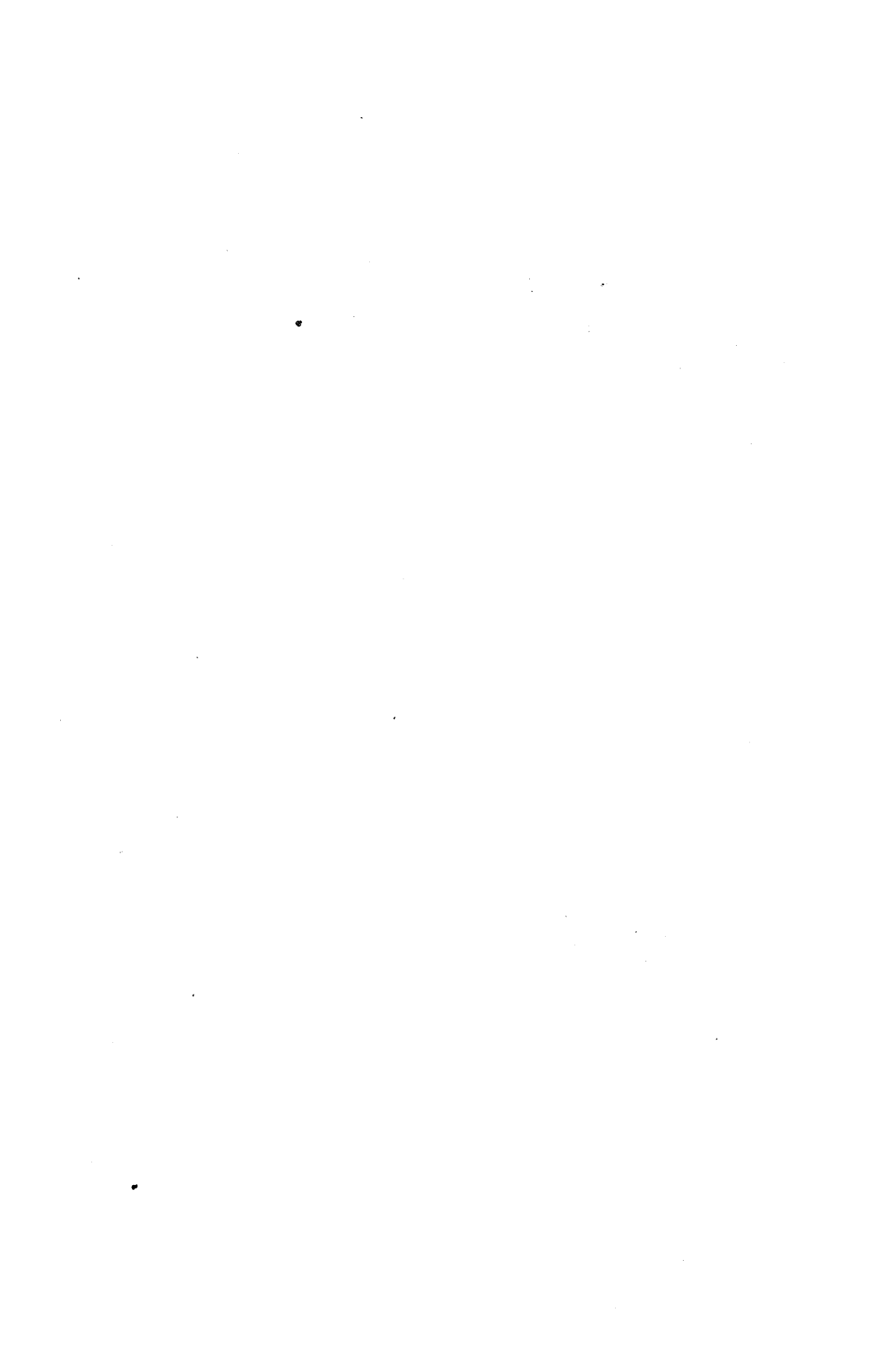
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to prohibit the catching of trout in Tufts, Dutton and
Grindstone ponds, and their tributaries, in the town of King-
field, Franklin county, for sale.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to catch any trout in Tufts,
2 Dutton or Grindstone ponds, or their tributaries, in the town
3 of Kingfield, Franklin county, for sale; and it shall be unlaw-
4 ful to sell any trout at any time taken from the above named
5 ponds or their tributaries.

Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to a penalty ten dollars for each offense.
