IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend section 2 of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes, relating to the construction of Public Drains and Sewers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes 2 is hereby amended by adding after the word "town" in the
- 3 first line thereof, the words 'or a committee duly chosen by
- 4 the town,' and also by adding after the word "health" in the
- 5 fourth line, the following words, 'but neither the municipal
- 6 officers of the town, nor such committee, shall construct any
- 7 public sewer therein until the same shall be authorized by
- 8 vote of said town, and an appropriation made for the pur-
- 9 pose; and in no case shall such municipal officers or com-

Io mittee incur any expense on behalf of the town for such pur-II pose, exceeding the amount appropriated therefor,' so that I2 said section when amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. The municipal officers of a town, or a committee 14 duly chosen by the town, may, at the expense of the town, 15 construct public drains or sewers along or across any public 16 way therein, and through any lands of persons or corporations, when they deem it necessary for public convenience or 18 health; but neither the municipal officers of the town, nor 19 such committee, shall construct any public sewer therein until 20 the same shall be authorized by vote of said town, and an 21 appropriation made for the purpose; and in no case shall 22 such municipal officers or committee incur any expense on 23 behalf of the town for such purpose, exceeding the amount 24 appropriated therefor; and when constructed such sewers 25 shall be under the control of the municipal officers.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
