STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to prevent ice fishing in Bonneg Beg and "L" ponds,
situated partly in North Berwick, Sanford and Wells, county
of York.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish at any time for any
2 kind of fish on or through the ice in Bonneg Beg pond, situ-
3 ated partly in North Berwick and partly in Sanford, or in
4 "L" pond, situated partly in Sanford and partly in Wells,
5 York county.

Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten nor more
3 than thirty dollars, and an additional penalty of one dollar for
4 each fish caught, taken or killed in violation thereof.
