STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to legalize and make valid the acts and doings of the city council of the city of Saco, pertaining to the annual appropriations and the commitment of taxes for the year 1900.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The acts and doings of the city council of
2 the city of Saco, in council meetings, so far as the same
3 relate to the raising of money by taxation, and the acts and
4 doings of the various officers of said city in the assessment,
5 commitment and collection thereof, for the year 1900, are
6 hereby made legal and valid.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
