STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to authorize cities and towns to establish manual training schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Cities and towns may raise and appropriate 2 money for the support of manual training schools in 3 addition to the sum they raise for the support of public 4 schools.
- Sect. 2. Said manual training schools shall admit such 2 persons between the age of six and twenty-one years, and 3 shall give such courses of instruction, as the local school 4 board may determine.

- Sect. 3. Said manual training schools shall be under 2 the control, direction and supervision of local school 3 boards.
- Sect. 4. Pupils in such schools shall be subject to the 2 same conditions, rules and regulations as are provided for 3 public schools.
 - Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
