STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of East Machias to erect and maintain a half tide dam across the East Machias river on or near the site of the former dam.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The town of East Machias is hereby authorized
2 to erect and maintain a half tide dam across the East Machias
3 river on the site of a former dam as now marked in said river
4 near the residence of Mrs. Pamela S. Nash.

Sect. 2. The said town is also authorized to appropriate
2 sufficient money to build said dam and to make from time
3 to time such further appropriations as may be necessary to
4 maintain the same at any regular town meeting or at any

5 special town meeting called for that purpose in the same
6 manner that other appropriations are made by the town and
7 with the same effect.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
