STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum
2 of eleven thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen
3 hundred and one, and eleven thousand five hundred dollars
4 for the year nineteen hundred and two, for the purpose of re-
5 pairing the first wing for women of the Maine Insane Hos-
6 pital. Said sum to be expended under the direction of the
7 trustees of insane hospitals.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The wing on the women's side (the one to be repaired) was built over sixty years ago, and has been in constant use all these years, and, as the institution has increased in number, has been occupied constantly by the most untidy of patients. All the wood-work must be removed because of decay and unsanitary condition. The heating and ventilation are very defective. The safety of the patients occupying this ward and also the safety of the institution demand that the repairs be made *now*.

The conservative estimate of the architect of the cost of this work is \$24,750.
