Resolve, That the sum of four thousand five hundred dollars

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Painting outside of school building. Ceiling for model room. Hard floors for recitation rooms and cloak rooms. Removing blackboards in main hall, steel finish and painting same. Painting and material for model room, laboratory, cloak rooms and entry. New water closets on both sides of building with modern ventilation for same. Stone steps for front and east side of building with porticos for same. Cementing basement of new wing. Additional heating apparatus. Grading grounds.

Estimated cost of above repairs, \$4,500.
