STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE laying a tax on counties of the state for the years nineteen hundred and one and nineteen hundred and two.

Resolved, That the sum annexed to the counties in the fol-2 lowing schedule is hereby granted as a tax on each county 3 respectively to be appropriated, assessed, collected and 4 applied to the purposes of paying the debts and necessary 5 expenses of the same and for other purposes ordered by 6 law:
