IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend section four of chapter 202 of the Private
and Special Laws of 1899, entitled "An Act for the better
protection of sheep in the town of Perry."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section four of chapter 202 of the Private and Special
2 Laws of 1899 is hereby amended by adding thereto the
3 following words: 'One-half of said fine shall go to the
4 complainant and one-half to the town of Perry aforesaid.'
5 So that said section shall read as follows:

'Any member of said tribe of Indians at Pleasant Point
7 that keeps a dog contrary to the provisions of this act shall
8 pay a fine of ten dollars or be punished by imprisonment

9 in the jail in the county of Washington for not more than
10 thirty days, one-half of said fine shall go to the complainant
11 and one-half to the town of Perry aforesaid.'
