## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT relating to the duties of the Board of State Assessors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be the duty of the board of state 2 assessors, and they are hereby directed to biennially in-3 vestigate and examine into the system and method of tax-4 ation of other states, and also to make careful and con-5 stant inquiry into the practical operation and effect of the 6 laws of the state of Maine, in comparison with the laws of 7 other states, with the view of ascertaining wherein the tax 8 laws of Maine are defective, inefficient, inoperative or in-9 equitable. They shall biennially incorporate the result of investigation 10 their and inquiry in their annual 11 report made prior to each legislative session,

12 and recommend therein such modifications, changes and 13 additions in the tax law of this state as may seem advis-14 able or necessary to secure a more just and equitable sys-15 tem of taxation.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
