STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of an appropriation for repairs of the
Normal school buildings at Gorham.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of three thousand dollars for the year 1901, for repairs upon
3 the Normal school building and dormitory at Gorham, said
4 appropriation to be expended by and under the direction of
5 the trustees of the Normal school of the state for the purposes
6 above mentioned.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The roof of the school building has become leaky and must be thoroughly repaired, and all the woodwork of the exterior painted in order to save it from the action of the weather. The furnace in the school building has become nearly useless and must be replaced by a new one. The floors and blackboards must be extensively repaired or replaced by new work.

The paint on the interior finish of the dormitory has become much worn by long use and should be renewed the present year, while the underpinning under the veranda has become partially upset by the action of the frost and must be reset. It is proposed also to erect on the dormitory an efficient system of fire escapes, as there is danger of great loss of life in case of fire under the present conditions.
