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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

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AN ACT to provide an assistant clerk for the Board of Rail-  
road Commissioners.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. There shall be an assistant clerk to the board  
2 of railroad commissioners, to be appointed by the gov-  
3 ernor, upon recommendation of the board, whose duty it  
4 shall be to assist the clerk in the performance of his duties,  
5 and in the absence of the clerk to have the same powers  
6 as the clerk.

Sect. 2. He shall have a salary of twelve hundred dol-  
2 lars per year, to be paid quarterly from the state treasury.

Sect. 3. The amount of said salary shall be assessed as  
2 provided for the salaries of the commissioners and clerk

3 by section four of chapter 313 of the Public Laws of the  
4 year 1889.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
