STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of A. J. Cameron.

Resolved, That the sum of six hundred and eighty dol-2 lars and seventy-seven cents be appropriated to pay the 3 claim of A. J. Cameron or such part of said claim as may 4 be found due, after a full examination by the governor and 5 council. Such settlement shall be in full for all claims of 6 said Cameron against the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The financial committee advise this appropriation so that the governor and council may have a fund with which to pay the claim of A. J. Cameron for binding and stitching in 1878 or any part thereof (not exceeding \$680.77) that they may find due him.
