STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Bath Military and Naval Orphan
Asylum.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated for
2 the Bath Military and Naval Orphan Asylum the sum of
3 eight thousand and five hundred dollars for the year 1901,
4 and eight thousand and five hundred dollars for the year
5 1902 ; also the sum of one thousand dollars for repairs for
6 the years 1901 and 1902.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This asylum was incorporated in 1866 for the support and education of children of persons who served in the service of the United States during the great rebellion and who were orphans or half orphans of said persons.

This asylum has been one of the charges of the state since that time and the care and management has been under the direction of trustees appointed by the governor and elected by the corporation. It is also inspected several times annually by a committee of the governor's council. For a full report of this institution, you are respectfully referred to the printed report which is presented to the legislature. The trustees respectfully ask that the appropriation, as asked for in the resolve be made, which is the same as in former years.
