STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter sixty-six of the Public Laws of
eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, relating to the jurisdiction
of municipal and police courts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Chapter sixty-six of the Public Laws of
2 eighteen hundred and ninety-nine is hereby amended so as
3 to read as follows:

‘A municipal or police court shall not have jurisdiction in
5 any civil matter unless the defendant resides within the
6 county in which such court is established, or is a non-resi-

7 dent of the state and has personal service within the county,
8 or a party summoned as trustee resides within the county, or
9 property of the defendant is attached within the county, in
10 which such court is established. But in case of such personal
11 service, trustee or attachment such court shall have jurisdic-
12 tion to the amount of the established jurisdiction of such
13 municipal or police court,' provided however that an at-
14 tachment of real estate hereunder shall not confer jurisdic-
15 tion upon any municipal or police court not a court of rec-
16 ord.
