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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

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AN ACT relating to and amendatory of chapter 376 of the  
Private and Special Laws of 1889, entitled "An Act to incor-  
porate the Crystal Ice Company."

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Maine Lake Ice Company, incorporated  
2 by the name of Crystal Ice Company under chapter 376 of  
3 the Private and Special Laws of 1889, the name of said com-  
4 pany having been changed in June, 1899, to Maine Lake Ice  
5 Company, is hereby authorized and empowered to increase  
6 its capital stock from one hundred thousand dollars to three  
7 hundred thousand dollars, and is further authorized and  
8 empowered to issue its bonds to pay, retire and cancel its  
9 outstanding bonds and the mortgage securing the same,

10 and for the further construction and improvement of its  
11 works and plant, and for other purposes of its incorporation,  
12 and for such amount and upon such rate and time as it may  
13 deem expedient, not to exceed the sum of two hundred  
14 thousand dollars; and to secure such bonds by mortgage or  
15 deed of trust of all or any part of its franchise, property,  
16 rights and privileges now owned or to be hereafter ac-  
17 quired.

Sect. 2. Said corporation may hold real and personal  
2 property to an amount not exceeding three hundred thou-  
3 sand dollars.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
