HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to open Main Stream, a tributary of Moose pond,  
above the dam near the outlet to fishing.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. So much of section 5 of chapter 30 of the Re-  
vised Statutes, as amended by chapter 42 of the Public  
Laws of 1899, as closes Main Stream, a tributary to Moose  
pond, in Hartland and Harmony, to fishing as provided in  
the general law, is hereby repealed.
