STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to protect screens in lakes, erected by authority of the state, and to permit ice fishing in Green lake, in the county of Hancock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Whoever shall take up, destroy or injure any
2 screen erected at the outlet of any lake or pond by authority
3 of the commissioners of inland fisheries and game, shall be
4 punished by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars for each of-
5 fense.

Sect. 2. So much of section 5 of chapter 30 of the Re-
2 vised Statutes, as amended by chapter 42 of the Public
3 Laws of 1899, as prohibits fishing through the ice in Green

4 lake, in Hancock county, is hereby modified so that it shall
5 be lawful to fish through the ice in said lake during the
6 months of February, March and April, on Fridays and Sat-
7 urdays of each week of each year, in the manner provided
8 in the general law for fishing through the ice.
