AN ACT to prevent the taking of fish from Ross and Conroy lakes, in Littleton and Monticello, in the county of Aroostook.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or  
2 kill at any time any kind of fish in Ross or Conroy lakes,  
3 in Littleton and Monticello, Aroostook county, for a period  
4 of five years, under the penalties provided in the general  
5 law for illegal fishing.
