
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to prevent the taking of fish from Ross and Conroy lakes, in Littleton and Monticello, in the county of Aroostook.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or

- 2 kill at any time any kind of fish in Ross or Conroy lakes,
- 3 in Littleton and Monticello, Aroostook county, for a period
- 4 of five years, under the penalties provided in the general
- 5 law for illegal fishing.
