STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and ninety-five of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Yarmouth Water Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter two hundred and ninety-
2 five of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and
3 ninety-five is hereby amended by inserting after the word
4 "Yarmouth" in the fifth line thereof, the words 'and North
5 Yarmouth,' so that said section as amended shall read as
6 follows:

'Sect. 1. Lorenzo L. Shaw, Alfred T. Small, John H.
8 Humphrey and George W. Hammond of Yarmouth, with

9 their associates and successors, are hereby made a corpora-
10 tion by the name of the Yarmouth Water Company, for the
11 purpose of supplying the inhabitants of Yarmouth and North
12 Yarmouth with suitable water for domestic, sanitary and
13 municipal purposes, including extinguishment of fire, with
14 all the rights and privileges, and subject to all the liabilities
15 and obligations of similar corporations, under the general
16 laws of this State.'

Sect. 2. Section two of chapter two hundred and ninety-
2 five of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and
3 ninety-five is hereby amended by inserting after the word
4 "any" in the fifth line thereof the word 'springs;' and by
5 inserting after the word "Yarmouth" in the seventh line
6 thereof the words 'and North Yarmouth,' so that said section
7 as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. For any of the purposes aforesaid, or for the
9 preservation and purity of said water, said corporation is
10 hereby authorized to take and use water from Royal river,
11 or from any spring, pond, brook or other water in the towns
12 of Yarmouth and New Gloucester, or from any springs,
13 brook or pond in the town of North Yarmouth; to conduct
14 and distribute the same into and through the said town of
15 Yarmouth and North Yarmouth; to survey for, locate, lay,
16 erect and maintain suitable dams, reservoirs and machinery,
17 pipes, aqueducts and fixtures; to carry its pipes or aqueducts
18 under, in and over the Royal river, so called, or under or
19 over any watercourse, bridge, street, railroad, highway or
20 other way; and said corporation is further authorized to
21 enter upon and excavate any highway or other way, in such

22 manner as least to disturb the same, and shall leave said ways
23 in as safe and passable condition as before such excavation ;
24 to enter, pass over and excavate any lands, and to take and
25 hold by purchase or otherwise, any real estate, rights of way
26 or of water, and in general to do any acts necessary, con-
27 venient or proper, for carrying out any of the purposes here-
28 inbefore specified. And said corporation is further author-
29 ized, for the purpose of making all needed repairs or exten-
30 sions or service connections, to lay its pipes through any
31 public or private lands or ways, with the right to enter upon
32 the same or dig therein, and said corporation may make
33 written regulations for the use of said water, and change the
34 same from time to time.'

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
