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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

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### AN ACT relating to the Mallison Power Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Mallison Power Company, a corpora-  
2 tion duly incorporated under the general laws of this state,  
3 in addition to the rights obtained thereby, and for the  
4 purposes contemplated in its original incorporation and in  
5 this act, is hereby authorized and empowered to issue its  
6 bonds or other evidences of indebtedness in such amounts  
7 and on such times and rates as it may from time to time  
8 determine, and secure the same by a mortgage of its prop-  
9 erty and franchises; increase its capital stock to any  
10 amount not prohibited by law, as it deems necessary;  
11 acquire in any legal manner, and hold, sell, lease or other-

12 wise convey all real and personal property and rights  
13 necessary for all said purposes, and is also authorized and  
14 empowered to carry on the business of making, generat-  
15 ing, using, selling, distributing, transmitting and supply-  
16 ing electricity for lighting, heating, manufacturing and all  
17 other legal purposes; and in the prosecution thereof to  
18 locate, construct, maintain, keep in repair and operate its  
19 lines with suitable poles, supports, wires, conduits and  
20 other apparatus upon, along, across, over or under any  
21 public highway, bridge, railroad or private land that it  
22 may find necessary or convenient to accomplish the pur-  
23 poses aforesaid, but in such manner as not to unnecessarily  
24 incommode or endanger the public use thereof; first  
25 having obtained the consent of the proper municipal  
26 officers of any city or town to such use of any highway or  
27 bridge therein, and the consent of the officers of any rail-  
28 road on which it is proposed to build its lines; with the  
29 right to remove trees and other obstructions when neces-  
30 sary, within the limits and for the purposes aforesaid,  
31 excepting fruit trees or any tree or shrub standing and  
32 growing for the purposes of shade or ornament.

Sect. 2. The damages for taking land under this act  
2 when the parties do not agree, shall be estimated, secured  
3 and paid as for land taken for railroads.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
