STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend and extend the charter of the Strong
Water Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The names of Charles E. Dyer and Clinton
2 V. Starbird are hereby substituted for those of Elias H.
3 Porter and Lionel True deceased, in section one of chapter
4 one hundred and forty-seven of the Private and Special
5 Laws of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine; and
6 all the rights, powers and privileges of the Strong Water
7 Company which were granted by said chapter one hundred
8 and forty-seven are hereby extended for two years addi-
9 tional.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
