STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter one hundred and seventy-six of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, entitled "An Act creating the Fryeburg Village Fire Corporation."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter one hundred and 2 seventy-six of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen 3 hundred and eighty-seven is hereby amended by adding to 4 said section the following words 'also for lighting their 5 streets, sprinkling the same, constructing and maintaining SENATE—No. 24.

6 sidewalks,' so that said section as amended shall read as 7 follows :

'Sect. 2. Said corporation is hereby invested with 9 power, at any legal meeting called for that purpose, to 10 raise such sums of money as may be sufficient for the pur-11 chase, repair and preservation of one or more fire engines, 12 engine houses, hose, buckets, hooks and ladders and other 13 apparatus for the extinguishment of fires; for the con-14 struction of reservoirs, aqueducts and hydrants for the 15 procuring of water, and for organizing and maintaining 16 within the limits of said territory, an efficient fire depart-17 ment; also for lighting their streets, sprinkling the same, 18 constructing and maintaining sidewalks.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
