IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT in relation to the Salaries of the Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

From and after the first day of April, in the year of our 2 Lord one thousand nine hundred and one, the annual

3 salary of each of the justices of the supreme judicial court

4 shall be four thousand dollars, payable from the treasury

5 of the state, in quarterly payments, on the first days of

6 January, April, July and October.
