## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to prohibit the pursuit and killing of duck and other water fowl by the use of launches or other craft propelled by other than hand power.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to pursue, hunt or 2 shoot duck or other water fowl upon any of the waters of 3 Maine in any launch or other craft propelled by steam, 4 naptha, electric or any other power other than by sails or 5 hand, under a penalty of fifty dollars for each offense.
