IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT in relation to the appointment of special fish wardens.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The commissioner of sea and shore fisheries shall have
2 power to appoint special wardens with the same powers and
3 duties of those wardens now recommended by him and
4 appointed by the governor.
