STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter one hundred and four of the
Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, relating
to the salary of Judge of municipal court of Bath.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and
2 four of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-
3 nine is hereby amended by striking out in the tenth and
4 eleventh lines the words "nine hundred" and inserting
5 instead thereof the words 'one thousand,' so that the said
6 section as hereby amended, shall read as follows :

'Sect. 1. A municipal court is hereby established in
8 and for the city of Bath and the towns of Woolwich,
9 Arrowsic, Georgetown, Phippsburg and West Bath in the
10 county of Sagadahoc, which shall be called the Bath

11 municipal court and have and use a seal on all original
12 processes, and shall consist of one judge who shall be
13 appointed, commissioned, and qualified as provided by
14 the law and constitution of the state. Said judge shall be
15 a member of the bar of Sagadahoc county and shall reside
16 during his continuance in office in the city of Bath, and
17 who shall receive from said city an annual salary of one
18 thousand dollars per year, to be paid him in quarterly
19 payments. Said salary shall be in full for all the fees and
20 emoluments of the office; provided, however, that he
21 shall receive in addition to said salary the legal fees for
22 all copies of processes and certificates by him made. The
23 present judge shall continue in office until the end of the
24 term for which he was appointed. The said judge shall
25 enter, or cause to be entered on the docket of said court
26 all civil and criminal actions, with full minutes of the
27 proceedings in and disposition of the same, which docket
28 shall be at all times open to inspection, and he shall per-
29 form all other duties required of similar tribunals in this
30 state.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
