STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to apportion representatives to Congress.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The counties of York and Cumberland shall 2 compose the first district, and be entitled to one represen-3 tative. The counties of Oxford, Franklin, Androscoggin, 4 Sagadahoc, Knox and Lincoln, shall compose the second 5 district, and be entitled to one representative. The 6 counties of Kennebec, Somerset, Waldo and Hancock, 7 shall compose the third district, and be entitled to one 8 representative. The counties of Penobscot, Piscataquis, 9 Aroostook and Washington, shall compose the fourth 10 district and be entitled to one representative. Sect. 2. The election of representatives to congress 2 shall take place and be on the second Monday of Septem-3 ber, one thousand nine hundred and two, and thereafter 4 biennially.

Sect. 3. The representatives chosen in the several dis-2 tricts, shall, at the time of their election be residents 3 therein. The foregoing division of the state into repre-4 sentative districts, shall be and continue in force until an 5 apportionment shall be made for representatives to con-6 gress after taking the thirteenth census.

Sect. 4. In case any vacancy among the representa-2 tives to congress requires an election prior to the second 3 Monday of September one thousand nine hundred and 4 two, or at any other time, then such vacancy shall be 5 filled by the proper district under this apportionment.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
