STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT authorizing the Milbridge and Cherryfield Electric Railroad Company to construct and operate its railroad over Narraguagus river in Milbridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Authority and permission is hereby given

- 2 and granted the Milbridge and Cherryfield Electric Rail-
- 3 road Company, a duly created corporation, to construct,
- 4 maintain and operate its proposed railroad over, along and
- 5 across the navigable tide waters of the Narraguagus river
- 6 in the town of Milbridge in the county of Washington, at
- 7 or near the northerly side of the big bridge, so called, and
- 8 the drawbridge as now constructed at that point in said
- 9 Milbridge, under the directions and approval of the board 10 of railroad commissioners.

- Sect. 2. Said company shall construct and maintain a 2 suitable drawbridge for the use of vessels in navigating 3 said river.
 - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
