IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND ONE.

---

AN ACT to prohibit fishing in Pleasant pond and its inlets,  
situated in Sumner, Oxford County.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. There shall be a close time in which it shall  
2 be unlawful to fish for any kind of fish in any way or at any  
3 time in Pleasant pond or its inlets, situated in the town of  
4 Sumner, Oxford county, for the term of three years from  
5 the approval of this act; and for the term of five years  
6 thereafter it shall only be lawful to fish on Tuesdays,  
7 Thursdays and Saturdays of each week and but twenty-  
8 five fish to be taken by any person in any one day.

Section 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of  
2 this act shall be subject to a penalty of ten dollars for  
3 each offense, and one dollar for each fish caught, taken or  
4 killed in violation thereof.
