
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to close the tributaries of Upper and Lower Stone ponds in the town of Stoneham.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
- 2 kill any kind of fish at any time in any of the tributaries of
- 3 Upper Stone pond and Lower Stone pond, in the town of
- 4 Stoneham.
 - Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act
- 2 shall be subject to the same penalties provided for illegal fish-
- 3 ing in the general law of the state.
