STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter thirty-five of the
Public Laws of 1891 relating to salaries of assistant super-
intendents, steward and matron at the Insane Hospital.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of chapter thirty-five of the Public
2 Laws of 1891 as amended by chapter three hundred and
3 eleven of the Public Laws of 1893 is hereby further amended
4 by striking out the word, "thirteen" in the tenth line thereof
5 inserting in place thereof the word 'sixteen,' so that said
6 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred fifteen of
8 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out lines

9 fifty-three, fifty-four, fifty-five, fifty-six and fifty-seven and
10 inserting instead thereof the following, four assistant super-
11 intendants of the insane hospital, one of whom shall be a
12 female, such sum as the trustees may from time to time vote
13 not exceeding thirty-five hundred dollars a year for the four ;
14 the steward, including his duties as treasurer, such sum as
15 the trustees may from time to time vote, not exceeding
16 sixteen hundred dollars in full for all services ; chaplain, three
17 hundred dollars ; matron, five hundred dollars.'

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this
2 act are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect as of January one, one
2 thousand nine hundred and one.
