STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to ratify the lease of the Patten and Sherman Railroad to the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The acts and doings of the Patten and Sherman Railroad Company in issuing its bonds and securing the same by mortgage dated January 1, 1901, of its railroad and franchise, and the acts and doings of the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad Company in guaranteeing the payment of said bonds and the interest thereon, and the lease of the said railroad to the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad Company by said Patten and Sherman Railroad Company, are all hereby made valid, ratified and confirmed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
