STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ONE.

AN ACT to regulate proceedings on certiorari.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

When the proceedings of any tribunal are brought up by 2 a writ of certiorari, the court may quash or affirm such pro-3 ceedings, or enter such judgment as the court below should 4 have rendered, or may make such order, judgment, or decree 5 in the premises as law and justice may require.
